SAMA PROPERTY ASSESSMENTS:

SAMA conducts revaluations are based on a four year cycle. 2013 was the year of the last revaluation, and the 2017 revaluation will see assessed values updated to reflect a new base date of January 1, 2015. The legislated base date means that 2017 values reflect a property's value as of January 2, 2015.

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLE BINS-

The Town of Kyle and RM of Lacadena recycle committee are trialing a single stream recycle system. The 1 year contract is with Tri-ways. Make sure you check both ends of the bin, if one side is full try the other end.

PLASTIC AND CARTON MILK JUGS:

Sarcan will be accepting these as of April 1, 2017 with a deposit refund of \$.10 or \$.25 depending on size.
