## **COUNCILLOR RESIGNATION:**

## SASKALERT APP:

<u>SaskAlert</u> is the Government of Saskatchewan's emergency public alerting program that provides critical information on emergencies in real time, so you can take action to protect yourself, your family and your property. An emergency alert issued though SaskAlert will let you know: what the emergency is, where it is happening, provide instructions for you to follow to stay safe, and advise you when the incident is over.

#### **CIVIC ADDRESS REGISTRY (CAR):**

CAR is used by the provincial 911 system and Administration staff has participated in the CAR Level 1 & 2 training. The end purpose is to have our civic addresses and streets correctly identified and registered in the CAR system. If your house or business does not have a number on it please do so as soon as possible.

#### FIRE HAZARD:

Please clean up any poplar fuzz as soon as is possible. It is extremely flammable and has been involved multiple fires around the province.

#### **STREET REPAIR:**

Street/ pot hole repair will begin in June weather pending. This is a reminder that when the town workers have a section of street blocked off while they repair it, it is your responsibility to avoid that street. It is for the workers safety that the sections of streets are blocked off, not to inconvenience you.

If you are reported to the RCMP for failing to acknowledge the road block you are subject to a \$125 fine as per Section 226 of the Transportation Safety Act.

## BYLAW 14-2017

- i) Truck and Trailer Parking:
  - i) No person shall leave a licensed trailer on a public boulevard or any other town owned property which is unattached from the vehicle used for moving same;
  - ii) Privately owned and properly licensed recreation camper trailers or livestock trailers may be parked on the street in residential areas in contravention of the subsection (i) from April 1 to October 31 of each year provided that they are parked adjacent to the owner's property and for a period of time not to exceed 96 consecutive hours.
