**PUBLIC WORKS CHEMICAL TREATMENT FOR TREE ROOTS**

If you missed the January chemical treatment of tree roots will be scheduled again on **Feb 25**. This takes approximately 15 minutes.

We have made changes to how we will be offering this service. Only customers who phone and set up an appointment during this week will receive the service.

**BUSINESS LICENSE RENEWAL**

Each January, all commercial businesses not operating out of commercial property are required to purchase a business license. This includes contractors, home offices, and home based businesses. All door to door sales people and street vendors must also purchase one. Business should not be conducted prior to the purchase of a license. Business licenses should be renewed early in the year and not later than the end of February.

Business licenses ensure that all business activity in the community are in compliance with Town Bylaws. They also provide businesses with an opportunity to be listed on the Town of Kyle website business directory.

We appreciate the community's assistance reminding businesses to get their license and refraining from purchasing a good or service until this has occurred.

**WASTE COLLECTION**

Discussions have been ongoing for some time about the current life span and renewal of the joint landfill owned by the Town and RM of Lacadena. The town is currently researching options for curb side pickup.
