TREE ROOT SEWER LINE CLEAN OUTS

FIRE BAN CURRENT STATUS

Effective June 24, 2019 the fire ban was rescinded. Please watch the town sign and Facebook page for current status should conditions become dry again. If a fire ban is in effect we will also place a sign in the town office window stating so.

Please note that the fire pit bylaw requires that a 1/4 “ mesh top be placed on a bonfire pit while in use.

TRIWAYS RECYCLE AND WASTE CARTS

Single Stream recycling change: effective immediately Triways will no longer accept Food Containers labelled as #1 and Film plastic (plastic bags and stretch wrap) for recycle. This is due to the recent changes in the recycling marketplace that have created a huge impact across the globe, negatively affecting commodity prices and the movement of material to end destinations.

LANDFILL UPDATE

Effective July 6, 2019 the Landfill hours will be : Fri and Sat – 9am – 12 pm and 1 pm to 5 pm. The only material accepted at the landfill will be clean wood, recycle metal and there will be a bin for large items like furniture.

A tipping fee of \$10 per visit will be applied to all NON-R.M. OF LACADENA RATEPAYERS (Town of Kyle and Clearwater Lake residents).

WATER RATE STRUCTURE CHANGE

The Town of Kyle pays the Saskatchewan Landing Regional Water Pipeline Utility for the monthly \$25 mainline and \$10 operating charges for every residence monthly even if the water is off. The following Bylaw 10-2019 was passed at the June 12, 2019 council meeting. This makes it fair to all residents that the fees are passed on equally to pay for the pipeline operation and the mainline loan repayment. ***There is NO CHANGE to current water users.***

BYLAW NO. 10-2019

A BYLAW TO AMEND THE WATER AND SEWER RATES BYLAW 492-2016

The Council of the Town of Kyle in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

That Bylaw No. 492-2016 be amended as follows:

- d. Property owners who request a water turn off for periods of time where the residence is vacant will have only the water and sewer rates stopped.
- e. Property owners who own a habitable residence and have a water meter installed or the ability to install a water meter and have a temporary or longer absence from that residence, shall be charged the monthly fee for the SLRWPU Operating charge of \$10.00 and SLRWPU Mainline charge of \$25.00.
- f. Commercial property with water and sewer service will be subject to SLRWPU charges as in (e) above
- g. Derelict or abandoned buildings are exempt at the discretion of the Administrator.
- h. This amendment comes into force and effect on the final day of passing thereof.
