Did you know Kyle EMS provides more than just emergency services?

They also provide a Community Paramedicine program service to patients that require, need, or want regular visits from a health care professional in their home.

What Kind of Services do Community Paramedics provide?

- ◆ Wellness Checks
- ◆ Blood Pressure Monitoring & Blood Glucose Monitoring
- ◆ Fall/Risk Assessments
- ◆ Recommendations and Referrals to other healthcare professionals
- ◆ Assist with Physio exercises at home (working with your therapists)
- ◆ Plus many more services

Is there a cost to receive Community Paramedic services?

No, Community Paramedic services are provided free of charge. Paramedics will visit clients as needed, frequency of visits are decided between the Paramedic and client.



How do I access Community Paramedicine services?

Referrals are required to receive Community Paramedicine services. Clients can be referred to the program by:

- ◆ Home Care
- ◆ Primary Care Provider/Physician
- ◆ EMS
- ◆ Primary Health Care Team
- ◆ Physio
- ◆ Other Health Care Professionals
- ◆ Self-Referral

How do I self-refer to the Community Paramedicine Program?

Anyone can self-refer to receive Community Paramedicine services by contacting their local EMS service.

Who are the Community Paramedics?

They are the same Paramedics you will get when you call 911, this is a service they provide while they are not on calls to better serve the community.
