TOWN OF KYLE BYLAW NO. 03-94

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE A UNIFORM SYSTEM FOR THE NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND OTHER BUILDINGS IN THE TOWN OF KYLE.

The council of the Town of Kyle in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- That a uniform system of numbering houses and other buildings as shown on the attached map and which shall become part of this bylaw shall be used in the Town of Kyle.
- 2. That all existing numbers of houses and other buildings not now conforming with the provisions of this bylaw shall be changed to conform to the system herein adopted.
- 3. Where areas have been subdivided into lots with 75 feet of frontage or less, a separate number shall be assigned for each lot. Where areas have not been subdivided, the numbers shall be assigned so as to correspond with adjacent subdivided lots.
- 4. Each house and/or building shall bear the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is situated. In case a house or building is occupied by more than one family dwelling unit or business, each separate front entrance of said house or building shall bear the number assigned to that lot, with the addition of a separate letter assigned to each dwelling or business unit.
- 5. Numerals indicating the official number of each house or building or each front entrance to such building shall be posted in a manner as to be visible from the street on which the property is located.
- 6. The Administrator of the Town of Kyle shall be responsible for maintaining the numbering system and shall keep a record of all numbers assigned under this bylaw.
- 7. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon conviction shall be liable to the penalty provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Kyle.
