BYLAW 06-2019
GENERAL PENALTY BYLAW

A Bylaw of the Town of Kyle to provide for penalties for contravention of bylaws.

The Council of the Town of Kyle in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the “General Penalty Bylaw” of the municipality.
2. Section 3 applies only to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other fine is provided.
3. Subject to the provisions of section 2, any individual found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of *The Municipalities Act*, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$2,000.00 and costs for every offence.
4. Subject to the provisions of section 2, any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of *The Municipalities Act*, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 and costs for every offence.
5. Bylaw No. 10-85 is hereby repealed.
