

09-2019 THE ANIMAL CONTROL BYLAW

Just a friendly reminder to dog owners to please remember to be respectful of your neighbors and keep in mind the bylaw when your pets are outside ☺ Please see section 9 of the Animal Control Bylaw below.

NUISANCE

- a. The owner, possessor or harbinger of a dog shall not allow the animal to create a nuisance to any person(s) by barking, howling, attempting to bite or biting anyone or any other dog, chasing vehicles or bicycles and any owner, possessor or harbinger who contravenes this section commits an offence under this bylaw.

05-1992 NOISE BYLAW

Now that the weather is nice and everyone is out working in their yards and enjoying the sunshine please be mindful of the quiet time hours. Please see paraphrased number 6 of section 3 of the Noise Bylaw below.

2. GENERAL REGULATIONS

6. Without restricting the generality of section 3, no person shall operate or be allowed to operate a lawnmower of any kind in any residential district between the hours of:

- a) 10:00PM and 7:00AM of the next day on week days;
- b) 10:00PM and 9:00AM of the following day which is a Sunday or holiday.

These time frames are set for all noise violations such as construction hours etc. Without a permit you may be liable to fines which are laid out in these bylaws.
