DEVELOPMENT, MOVING DEMOLITION AND BUILDING PERMITS

The Town of Kyle Zoning Bylaw 11-2020 sets out regulations in regards to buildings such as storage sheds, garages, houses and commercial buildings that are 100 sq ft or larger.

If you are planning on building or moving in any of the above, the first document we require is a development permit, which can be picked up at the Town Office. The development permit application is a request for what you want to do in which area. This is then referred back to the Zoning Bylaw to see if the request is permitted in that zone.

When the development permit is approved by Council, then a building permit is required if you are building a structure or a "moving" permit is required if you are moving a building onto your property. A "Demolition" permit is required if you are removing a structure from your property. Please come to the office for these forms.

Any buildings being moved in or built that are 100 sq ft or larger must be inspected by a building inspector. The application for the building inspector can be picked up in the office as well.
