POLICY UPDATES

Two new policies have been introduced regarding Water Services. These policies are to clearly set the responsibility for maintenance and repair costs for the homeowner and the town. The policies fall under the guidelines of the *Municipalities Act* and Town of Kyle Bylaw #07-2020.

Under the *Municipalities Act* it states under Service connections section 28(1) The owner of a parcel of land is responsible for the construction, maintenance, repair and replacement of a service connection of a public utility located above, on or under the parcel, unless otherwise determined by the municipality.
